### Missionaries to Brazil

an excerpt from a recent prayer letter....

During every championship game there is a point when the action becomes frenzied, the players give it all they've got, and the action becomes very fast paced. It usually happens in the last quarter and especially as the game draws down to a close. That is the best way I can describe our state of deputation as we have surpassed the three quarter mark. Things have been moving very rapidly and God has been blessing tremendously. In the latter half of the year we spent four weeks in Louisiana and ministered in 4 churches. During that time, we had the privilege of seeing 3 of those churches partner with our ministry! We drove from there to Pennsylvania where the Lord again added churches to our ministry. Last year we gained an unprecedented 37% support which now places us at 78% of our support. What that boils down to in numbers is that we now only need 8 more churches and we are set to head to Brazil. God has been showing His sovereignty in how he has been bringing pastors and churches across our paths. He has been using "chance" meetings with pastors at places such as restaurants and even Walmart. God has been so clearly and divinely orchestrating our schedule.

Now we are starting the process of going through and deciding what to take to Brazil and what to sell. Now that we have reached this point, we will next be working on our passports. Enough of a process for one person; a much larger undertaking for eight. Lord willing, the passports will be processing in the system while we are in Louisiana and be ready upon a return. From there we can begin the process of filing the paperwork for the Visas. Please pray for wisdom as Ashley and I are considering a two week trip to Brazil in order to establish housing and transportation for when we move there. We praise the Lord that we have the majority of our outfit and passage covered and only need about 40% more. Please pray for the Lord to provide the rest of what we need to travel to and get established in Brazil.
