Missionaries to Zambia

an excerpt from a recent prayer letter....

It has been a busy fall for us reporting to our supporting churches. We spent our time in Ohio, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois and Missouri in several Missions Conferences and church services. It is a blessing to see the Lord working in the hearts of His people. Everywhere we go we see the effects of the bad economy. Even though the economy is in a downturn, many of the conferences we participated in we witnessed God's people meet or exceed the need. In our last letter I mentioned one of our goals this furlough is to raise an additional \$500.00 per month support to meet the ever increasing need in Zambia. With our furlough half over we have one new supporting church and others have increased their monthly support to meet half of our needed monthly increase. We also need to raise special project money to continue working on our youth camp in Zambia and to build a church building for one of our new churches. We have been saving where possible and setting aside our love offerings to help meet this need. To date we have saved \$14,500.00. The total needed is \$30,000.00. If you can help with this need, send your gift marked "youth camp."

I have been in contact with the pastors in Zambia via email and phone calls. They all report that the work is going forward and they are seeing souls saved. The totals for this year are as follows. Bible Baptist Church of Kaloko reported 40 saved and 28 baptized. Calvary Baptist Church of Kabushi reported 52 saved and 13 baptized. Grace Baptist Church of Ndeke reported 10 saved and 5 baptized. Twikatane Baptist Church reported 28 saved and 11 baptized. Grace Baptist Church of Twashuka reported 19 saved and 2 baptized. Cornerstone Baptist Church of Buntungwa reported 68 saved and 6 baptized. Seekers Baptist Church of Mukolwe reported 10 saved and 3 baptized. With the nine saved at youth camp this year we had a total of 236 saved and 68 baptized in 2009. Praise the Lord. Thank you for enabling us to serve Christ in Zambia.
