Missionaries to Burkina Faso

an excerpt from a recent prayer letter....

For the past couple of months, we have been driving to the village of Mogtedo with Paul Sayouga in anticipation of his starting a church. The village is about an hour and a half drive east of Ouagadougou. It is a fairly large city and in need of a good church. God has laid it upon Paul's heart to start a work there. He will be stepping out on faith to see what God will do in that place.

During our visits there, we have been doing evangelism outreaches, with several people accepting Christ as their Savior. We have also been passing out literature and information about the new church starting up. The village for the most part seems receptive, but there does appear to be some obstacles forming. In Burkinabe villages, it is customary to get permission from the chief of the village to start a church or any other organization. As such, Paul wanted to keep with traditions and has met several times with the chief. It appears as though the chief is after money and wants to acquire some from Paul for allowing him to start a church. The chief's reputation in the village is not good and he is known to be a drunk by many.

Please pray for this situation, that God would work in the heart of this chief; that the chief would not try to extort money from God's work to finance his "habits." Greater still, pray for a miracle: for the chief's salvation. While we, as Baptists, do not hold to "signs and wonders" as some do, is there any greater miracle than when a man meets Jesus and God totally changes his life? What an example of God's grace this would be to the whole village. Pray with us for this to happen!!!

Also, Joshua has been having some health problems with fainting and trembling. Please keep this matter in your prayers.
