In November I spoke in Texas and mentioned a ministry we spearheaded on a large Marine Base. A young man told me after, that in that very ministry 3 of his friends had been saved and their lives changed! I then called the Point Man who leads the ministry there, and he said they recently had to double the earlymorning meetings, with 300 attending each meeting!

It has been so encouraging to be at all these bases, seeing America's heroes blooming in churches, with their young families.

Since writing last, I have been to Fort Bliss, Fort Huachuca, Ft. Carson, Petersen AFB, and Davis-Monthan AFB. All of these stops are pioneer projects, with a strategy of reaching, training and networking people-both military and church. That's Phase A. Phase C is when a working ministry is handed over. Space will not allow to detail God's help at each town!

Pray as we try to get the Gospel to these young hearts when they are the most vulnerable and the most valuable. They either go hard after God, or the Devil. If they go after God, the influence and leadership they exert for the cause of Christ is phenomenal.

PTSD Ministry

I have counseled many people suffering with Post Traumatic Stress lately; a couple weeks ago I was with a veteran, who as a boy had grown up with the shame of starting a fire at age 5, and in horror seeing his sisters perish in the flames. Who then hit the teen years and went to Vietnam; where 2 days into deployment he saw his best buddy killed. Then his medic was blown up and died in his arms. We went together to the "Man of Sorrows" who wiped away our tears. "The bud is blooming" and he now helps in PTSD ministry.

PTSD Ministry has proven to cut through many of the objections and redtape that we normally encounter. Please pray as we point many closed-up people to the beautiful Lily of the Valley.
